This may lead to some incidents happening among children. The topic of this meeting will be on how to deal with bullying at schools. Icebreaker is an anti-bullying workshop that helps people identify not only the different types of bullying but also the unsaid signs. It also gives tools to young people and adults supporting young people to overcome bullying situations.

Jamie Masters, Youth Community Connector and Josh Fuimaono Youth Facilitator from Yes Disability Resource Centre will deliver the presentation in English and it will be interpreted into Mandarin.
